

The Lawrence Library.

In five minutes on Monday Senator Henley passed a bill through the senate placing the Lawrence Carnegie library under the provisions of the new state library law.

The site for the library has been donated, the gift of Mrs. Charles P. Grosvenor, and the \$25,000 given by Andrew Carnegie is now available.

The law authorizes the mayor to appoint a library commission with authority to erect the library building, and equip it. Before the year is out, Lawrence will have one of the finest library buildings in the state, and before many years, we shall have one of the best libraries in the west in the building.
